5. Main text with CRYSTAL abstract, acknowledgement and logo from European Union, ARTEMIS and FP7 to comply with the regulations set forth in the Grant Agreement.

The elements 1 until 3 are repeatedly visible on all pages and subpages of the CRYSTAL website. Therefore, they are not visible in the subsequent screenshots of the CRYSTAL pages.





The subsite “News” is linked to the news corner on the CRYSTAL Homepage. Here, more detailed information on the events, activities... promoted is provided.

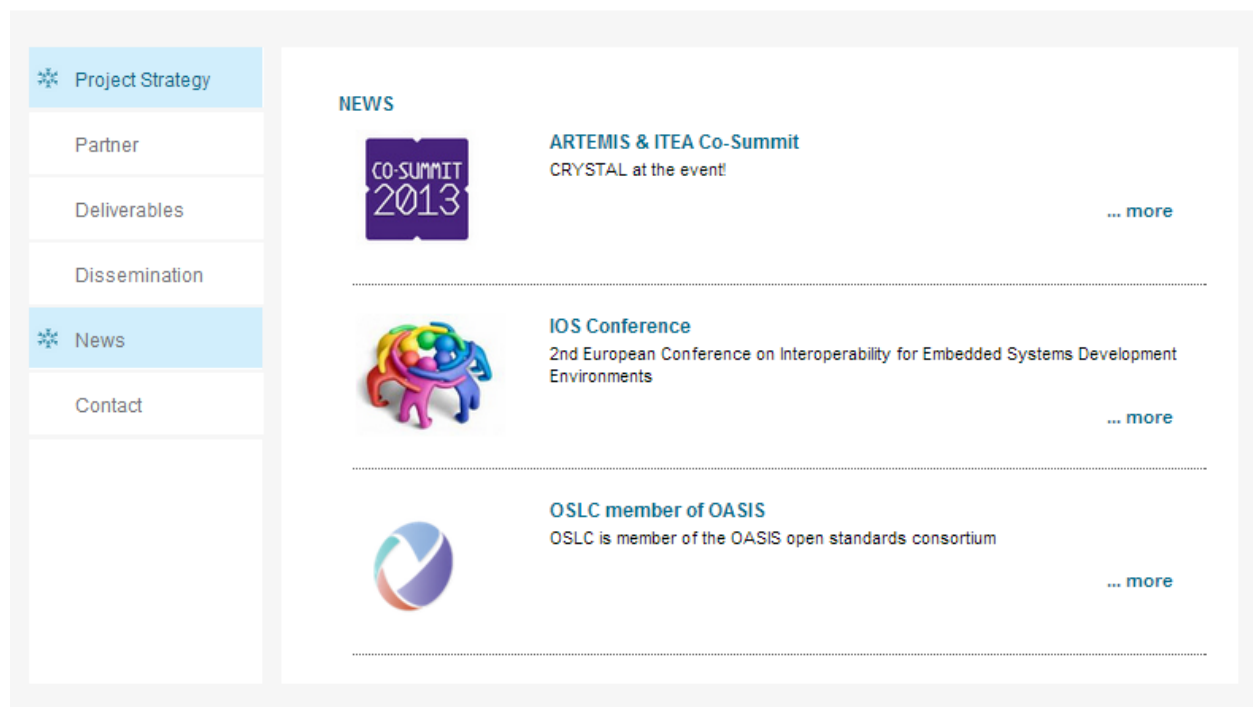


Figure 6-1: Subsite "News"


